

REQUEST FOR BIDS

Subject to conditions prescribed by the University of California, Irvine Medical Center, sealed bids for a lump sum Contract are requested for the following work:

USP 800 Compliance Upgrades – B23 & PMP, Project No. 994646

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Remodel of existing pharmacy space to create a separate hazardous drug storage area to comply with mandated USP 800 regulations. There are two individual pharmacy locations included in this one bid package. One is at the UCI Medical Center, Building 23, 2nd floor infusion pharmacy. The other location is the Pacific Medical Plaza, 4th floor. This project will also remodel existing areas at both locations in order to create the new space.

Excluded from the Scope:

- 1) Pharmacy Equipment

PROJECT COMPLETION TIME: 90 calendar days.

PROJECT DELIVERY: Traditional (Bid-Build)

ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COST: \$447,000

LICENSE REQUIREMENT: Current and active "B" General Contractors CA contractor's license.

INFORMAL BID REQUIREMENTS: For construction value between \$300,000 and \$640,000, Bidder and its mechanical, electrical and plumbing subcontractor(s) (if using) shall be qualified under the University's standards prior to award.

The work described in the contract is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

No contractor or subcontractor, regardless of tier, may be listed on a Bid for, or engage in the performance of, any portion of this project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 and 1771.1.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
