Under the guidelines of CA Public Contract Code 10510.4 – 10510.9, the UC Irvine Medical Center (hereinafter referred to as the "University") is seeking the best qualified firm or individual to provide Inspector of Record (IOR) Services for various new construction, renovation and remodel projects. Projects may be located at the UC Irvine Medical Center campus and other off-site Medical Center facilities in Orange County. Projects may be under the jurisdiction of the Office of State Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) or the State Fire Marshal. Firms and individuals with OSHPD (Class A), Department of the State Architect (DSA) and International Code Council (ICC) certifications are sought. Firms and individuals with OSHPD (Class B) certifications will also be considered.

Inspection services will be authorized on an as-needed basis and are contingent upon project approvals, funding and the quality of services delivered by the selected IOR.
