UCI Health, one of California's largest academic health systems, is the clinical enterprise of and powered by the University of California, Irvine. The 1,317-bed system comprises its main campus UCI Medical Center in Orange, Calif., the UCI Health — Irvine medical campus, four hospitals and affiliated physicians of the UCI Health Community Network in Orange and Los Angeles counties and ambulatory care centers across the region.

Hospitals

UCI Medical Center is a 459-bed acute care hospital providing tertiary and quaternary care, ambulatory and specialty medical, behavioral health and rehabilitation services. It is the primary teaching location for the UC Irvine School of Medicine.

The UCI Health Community Network, established in 2023, comprises UCI Health — Fountain Valley, UCI Health — Lakewood, UCI Health — Los Alamitos and UCI Health — Placentia Linda.

The UCI Health — Irvine acute care hospital opens late 2025.
