Program details

During the week, students will:

- Shadow and learn from physicians, nurses, administrators, research scientists and allied health professionals.
- Participate in hands-on labs and procedure simulations.
- Receive personalized college counseling, including test preparation, essay clinic and interview coaching.
- Collaborate on a digestive health awareness project.
- Complete American Heart Association Basic Life Support training.
- Meet mentors and local like-minded peers.
- Graduate with a certificate of completion and reference letter for college applications.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided daily.
- Receive a set of scrubs and a graduation reception for families.

Program begins at 7:30 a.m. and goes until 5 p.m. daily. Students may drive themselves or, parents to pick up student in a designated area.
