

Facts and figures

UCI Health, one of California’s largest academic health systems, is the clinical enterprise of and powered by the University of California, Irvine. The 1,461-bed system comprises its main campus UCI Medical Center — Orange, California, the UCI Health — Irvine acute care hospital and medical complex, four hospitals and affiliated physicians of the UCI Health Community Network in Orange and Los Angeles counties and ambulatory care centers across the region.

Hospitals

UCI Health — Orange is a 459-bed acute care hospital providing tertiary and quaternary care, ambulatory and specialty medical, behavioral health and rehabilitation services. It is the primary teaching location for the UC Irvine School of Medicine.

The all-new UCI Health — Irvine is a 144-bed acute care hospital providing emergency, digestive health, neurology, oncology and orthopedic services.
