OCTA ACCESS Transportation For Seniors:

 - Curb-to-curb service.
 - Transportation is \$3.60 each way. Trips must be scheduled at least 24 hrs. in advance.
 - No mileage limit as long as the trip is in Orange County. A personal care attendant is allowed to travel for free. A companion can travel for \$3.60 each way.
 - Same day taxi service is available at a cost of \$3.60 for a 5 mile trip. Any additional mileage over 5 miles is paid by the rider.

Non-Emergency Medical Appointment Transport Providers:

If you are NOT eligible for the OCTA ACCESS program, this service is available. Call The Office on Aging at 1–800–510–2020 for a referral.

- This service is provided to both South and North County residents.
- The cost is \$2.00 in each direction.

Description: Provides discounted taxi vouchers for senior resident travel within the City of Orange to grocery stores, pharmacies, medical appointments, and the senior center.

- Eligibility: 60 years and older; must be City of Orange resident
- Languages: English
- Application Process: Pre-registration required, please call to schedule an appointment
- Payment methods: Set program fee
- Program Fees: \$5 for six one-way vouchers
- **Documents Required**: Government issued picture ID, Proof of residence within coverage area

Senior Mobility Program:

The SMP program was developed to provide transportation services for seniors 60 years and older residing in the cities of Central/West Orange County and North Orange County. These services are used to transport seniors to the community centers in Westminster and Midway City. Additional trips will be provided to governmental agencies such as the Department of Social Security, Veteran's Services Office, Department of Immigration, Department of Social Services, Healthcare Agency, Office on Aging, etc. Abrazar (see next page) will provide limited trips to grocery, shopping and personal care destinations.

<u>ABRAZAR (Senior Non-Emergency Medical Transportation Program)</u>:

The program was developed to provide Seniors with access to nonemergency medical appointments including but not limited to dialysis, therapy, dentistry, prescription pick-ups, lab tests, x-rays, etc.

- 2. Rides must be scheduled a minimum of 5 days in ahead. Calling 5 days in advance does not guarantee an appointment. Same day appointments depend on availability.
- 3. Rides are limited to 15 miles within Orange County and within 10 miles outside of Orange County.
- 4. Rides are available to the following locations which may exceed the 15 mile limit:
 - Long Beach VA
 - Kaiser Lakeview
 - Irvine/Sand Canyon
 - UCI Medical Center in Orange
- St. Joseph's Hospital in Orange
- Newport Beach Dialysis Center
- Whitaker Wellness Institute in Newport Beach
- 5. Clients are limited to 16 one-way trips per month.
 - Exceptions to the 16-ride limit are made on a case-by-case basis.
 - Please inquire about exceptions for chemotherapy, dialysis, radiation, physical therapy, and other special circumstances.
- \$2.00 DOLLAR FEE DONATION PER TRIP. Care attendants may also ride free of charge.
- 7. Transportation Hours: Monday thru Friday from 7:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.
- 8. Transportation is not available on major holidays.
 - *All trips exceeding 15 miles in length are subject to program funding and availability

PACE Program (Programs of Allinclusive Care for the Elderly)

An all-inclusive care program established by Medicare to help seniors avoid nursing homes and instead, receive the care and services necessary to help them stay safe, comfortable, and remain living in their home. However, if it is determined that the program can no longer provide the support needed to keep the participant living safely at home, the program will pay for care in a skilled nursing home.

Individuals living in an assisted living facility, if eligible, can enroll in the PACE program as well. This can reduce the amount of care services you would need to pay to the assisted living facility, thereby reduces your cost.

Who is Eligible?

Independent individuals, 55yrs and older, who may require some assistance in performing activities of daily living but can still live in their homes and engage in the community with the help of PACE services.

Health Assessment Program for Seniors (HAPS)

If you have complex, chronic conditions and are seeking a comprehensive consultation, the Health Assessment Program for Seniors (HAPS) at UCI Health can help you get on the path to a healthier, happier life.

This unique consultation — the only one of its kind in Orange County — takes place in two parts:



First, you will meet with our team. The team includes a geriatrician, neuropsychologist, social worker, pharmacist, occupational therapist and dietitian. During this meeting, our team reviews medical records, prescriptions, living situation, and more in order to identify issues you may be having.



Next, in about two to three weeks after the first meeting, we will meet with you and your family to review our recommendations. These recommendations can be shared with your healthcare provider.

Our ultimate goal is to help older adults live more productive, healthy lives and to help families negotiate the difficult tasks of providing for care.

Memory Assessment Services



Have you ever misplaced your keys, forgotten a phone number or drawn a blank when trying to recall someone's name? For some people, this type of forgetfulness is a normal part of aging and generally not a cause for concern.

When memory loss becomes disabling or interferes with daily living, it may be a warning sign of something more.

Geriatricians, physician assistants, pharmacists, social workers, psychologists and nurses all work together to provide a comprehensive approach for patients with concerns about their memory.

- Must meet the financial requirements.
