Prevent infections during hospital stay

HOW TO APPLY Nasal 10% Povidone-Iodine (Iodophor)



Apply nasal povidone-iodine antiseptic swabs* to all adult patients on contact precautions <u>twice</u> <u>daily for 5 days on admission</u> to help remove germs and prevent infection



Clean nostrils (including tip) with tissues prior to application



Insert swab into one nostril and rotate for 30 seconds, or at least 3 times around slowly, covering all surfaces. Discard swab.



Repeat with 2nd swab in other nostril

Do NOT blow nose if solution drips. Gently wipe with a tissue.

Instructions

- Apply iodophor swabs* twice daily for 5 days on admission
- Clears bacteria that live in the nose that can cause infection, like S. aureus (including MRSA)
- 80% of *S. aureus* infections are caused by bacteria in the patient's own nose

Povidone-lodine use in specific circumstances

- If nasal device in place (NG tube), swab around tubing if possible
- If nasal packing in place, do not apply to that nostril
